This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into and effective as of 14 July 2017 ("Effective Date") amongst:

Mahindra & Mahindra Limited, a Company incorporated under the Indian Companies Act 1913 through its TRUCK AND BUS DIVISION and having its registered office at Gateway Building, Apollo Bunder, Mumbai - 400 001, and hereinafter referred to as 'MTBD (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns) on One Part.

Anurag Engineering College, owned and AND  
supervised by Amartya Educational Society ("Institute"), a Registered Society incorporated  
Under the Act 4 of 1956 and having its office at Hyderabad, India MTBL and  
the Institute are hereinafter referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

#### WHEREAS

- MTBD is a Division of Mahindra & Mahindra Limited and is involved in the sales and distribution of the state of the art technology automobiles;
- MTBD as a part of its global 'Corporate Image and Business Policy, conducts programs on various aspects of automobile manufacturing and servicing referred to as 'Mahindra Trucks & Bus Division Special Technical Education Program for Students' or 'M - SHIKSHA' to Indian student community who are undergoing certain specified and government recognized technical course;

- III Mahindra Institute of Learning Excellence 'EXTRAMILE' a division of MTBD is authorized by MTBD to implement and conduct and impart 'M - SHIKSHA' to students undergoing the DAE (i.e., Diploma in Automobile Engineering) in certain selected Polytechnics in India that are recognized by the 'State Technical Education Board' or by any other equivalent or appropriate board or authority;
- IV The Institute is one of the Polytechnic selected by MTBD for the implementation of the 'M - SHIKSHA' on certain terms and conditions as mentioned in the below draft and given its consent for conducting the 'M - SHIKSHA'

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:-**

1. ABOUT 'M - SHIKSHA' AND PROCEDURE TO CONDUCT THE PROGRAM:-
- (A) 'M - SHIKSHA' or Mahindra Special Technical Education Program for students is a training program developed by MTBD, for fulfilling its corporate social responsibilities.
- (B) MTBD through 'EXTRAMILE' will plan and implement the 'M - SHIKSHA' in accordance with the education pattern in India.
- (C) The Institute shall be given a 'Certificate of Association' ('CA' for reference) by MTBD indicating the selection of the Institute for the purposes of implanting 'M - SHIKSHA'. In addition to the 'CA', MTBD through EXTRAMILE shall also provide to the Institute an 'M - SHIKSHA' Certificate' to be distributed to the students, who would successfully undergo 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (D) The Institute fully understands that 'M - SHIKSHA' is a program in addition to the regular syllabus prescribed to the Institute by the Respective "State Technical Education Board' or any other Appropriate 'Regulating Board or Body' as prescribed by the State or the Law ("Core Curriculum").
- (E) The Institute also understands that 'M - SHIKSHA' is not a part or Requirement of the Core curriculum and 'M - SHIKSHA' may or could be recognized only by the Private Sector Industry and may not be recognized by the Employment Exchange or Government Companies or State Owned Manufacturing Units or State Owned Corporations or State Technical Education Board or the All India Council for Technical Education or NCVT or by any State or Central Education Board or by any legislation in force.
- (F) MTBD shall provide training at any EXTRAMILE Locations, at the Institute or at the MTBD dealership located at the nearest point to the Institute. The decision of MTBD shall be final in this regard.
- (G) MTBD will plan and implement through their trainers/ or selected service providers ('EXTRAMILE Instructor') the 'M - SHIKSHA' to the students and Faculty of the Institute perusing / conducting the Diploma Course in the Institute in the manner as prescribed by MTBD

(H) MTBD shall provide the aggregates and study materials, and training equipment's required, if any for the implementation of 'M - SHIKSHA'. However it shall be responsibility of the Institute to keep the aggregates in safe and good condition. The institute will arrange these aggregates at an exclusive place which shall be designated as "MTBD Corner". For the first 5 years period the aggregates would be in the name and shall be the property of MTBD.

(I) The 'M - SHIKSHA' is a combination of both theory and practice. The Institute and EXTRAMILE Instructors shall impart the theory part of the 'M - SHIKSHA' in the selected premises while the practice on the Job Training (Practical Training) of 'M - SHIKSHA' shall be imparted at the EXTRAMILE location or at MTBD dealers located at nearest distance to the institute.

## 2. COVENANTS BY THE INSTITUTE:-

- (A) The Institute understands and agrees that the implementation of 'M - SHIKSHA' is only for the branch of the Institute situated at the selected location and not for any other branch or wing. All the selected students of the Institute who is undergoing the "Diploma in Automobile Engineering" course may undergo 'M-SHIKSHA' along with, in addition to the Core Curriculum during the Final year of their DIPLOMA course.
- (B) The Institute agrees to display the 'CA' at its branch in such a place where the plaque is visible to all. The Institute understands that the CA shall remain the property of MTBD. If MTBD or Institute for any reasons whatsoever decides not to continue the 'M - SHIKSHA' for the next academic year or stops the implementation during the midst of the academic year for any reason stated in the MOU or the MOU is terminated in accordance with the provision mentioned herein by any of the parties or by act of law or court, then the Institute shall promptly return the 'CA' to MTBD. The CA shall be returned to MTBD even after the successful five year implementation of the 'M - SHIKSHA' or the extended implementation period thereafter.
- (C) The Institute shall not make replication or copy or photocopy of CA in any manner for the purposes of its display in any of its other branch or wing. The CA shall be displayed only in the 'M - SHIKSHA' Branch.
- (D) The Institute agrees to upgrade the facilities and resources in the 'M - SHIKSHA' Branch, as instructed by MTBD, in the year of entering the MOU and thereafter the said facilities and resources shall be maintained in good and proper condition and updated from time to time as required by MTBD. MTBD may make annual inspection on the condition of the facilities and resources every year and if required may request the Institute to carry out proper maintenance work. If the Institute fails to upgrade its facilities and resources or maintain the same then MTBD shall have no obligation to implement the 'M - SHIKSHA' in the next academic year.

- (E) The Institute agrees not to charge any additional fees or charges or monies under any heading whatsoever from any of the students who are selected for the 'M - SHIKSHA' for the purposes of or on the pretext of imparting the 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (F) The Institute agrees to be transparent in the selection procedure of the students for the 'M - SHIKSHA' course and shall try to select only those people having the best aptitude for the automobile industry.
- (G) The Institute shall not in any way or manner or fashion either directly or indirectly, reveal to any person or media or body or company or organization or to any competitor about any confidential details of either MTBD or EXTRAMILE that the Institute may come to know by the virtue of the MOU or through the implementation of 'M - SHIKSHA'. Any violation of this clause or any intention of violation of this clause may result in MTBD terminating the MOU with immediate effect. The decision of MTBD shall be final in this regard and there shall be no claims or litigation over MTBD in this regard.
- (H) If the appropriate authorities change the core-curriculum the Institute shall inform MTBD about the same and if so required, MTBD shall make suitable changes in the implantation of the 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (I) The Institute agrees to permit the students to visit the MTBD dealers whenever called by MTBD for the purposes of the practical training of 'M - SHIKSHA' without affecting the regular Diploma Engineering program of the Institute. However the arrangements and the costs of the traveling of the students from the Institute to the dealership and back to the Institute shall be made and borne by the students themselves and MTBD shall not be responsible for the same.
- (J) The Institute shall ensure that its students maintain discipline while they are in the premises of MTBD dealership and the students shall not interact with any of the customers of MTBD in the dealership or with any of the dealer staff or personnel unless called to do so by MTBD. The Institute shall ensure that the students shall at all times display significantly the identity card issued to them by the Institute. The students shall during their visit to the MTBD dealerships wear the normal uniform of the Institute that is worn in the workshop or laboratory of the Institute. The instructor/s from the Institute shall compulsorily accompany the students during their visit to the MTBD dealership and shall stay with the students in the MTBD dealership till the completion of On the Job Training. Further either the staff of MTBD or the staff of the MTBD dealer shall also be compulsorily present during the time of the On the Job Training and shall try to clarify all the queries or doubts that the students may raise and shall endeavor to provide the best possible training to the students. The Institute agrees not to transfer any of the students in the 'M - SHIKSHA' branch to any of its other branch or vice versa without the prior written permission of MTBD.
- (K) *The Institute shall inform MTBD about any student discontinuing the 'M - SHIKSHA' course to enable MTBD to plan its procurement of training material and planning of the training.*
- (L) *The Institute shall in no way whatsoever use the name or trademark or logo of either MTBD or EXTRAMILE in any of its advertisements or buildings or prospectus or application without the prior written consent of MTBD*

- (M) The Institute agrees not to make any commercial use or take any commercial advantage of its selection by MTBD for the implementation of the 'M - SHIKSHA'. The Institute fully understands that MTBD at its discretion could recognize any other institution also along with or without this Institute for the implementation of 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (N) The Institute recognizes the right of MTBD to make regular, frequent and informed inspections to the Institute any point of time during the working hours to oversee the implementation of 'M - SHIKSHA' and take stock of the equipment and to suggest improvements in the training methodology of 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (O) The Institute agrees that all the training kit and aggregates ('Equipment'; for reference) given to the Institute by MTBD under the MOU shall remain the property of MTBD for the first 5 English Calendar years from the date of the MOU and the Institute shall not tamper or destroy or copy or move the same in any manner whatsoever without the prior written consent of MTBD. Further during these first 5 English Calendar years, the Institute shall not take the stock of these Equipment's into its books of accounts or consider the same as its assets for availing any tax or other advantage. Any action by the Institute in violation of this clause shall entitle MTBD to discontinue the 'M - SHIKSHA' with immediate effect and the Institute shall make no claim whatsoever against MTBD or EXTRAMILE in this regard. MTBD at any point of time during the first 5 English Calendar years from the date of the MOU has the right to replace the Equipment for any reason whatsoever and in the event of the termination of the MOU before the completion of first 5 English Calendar years. MTBD has the right to take the entire Equipment back and the Institute shall have no claim over the same. However if 'M - SHIKSHA' is implemented successfully for the first 5 English Calendar years, then MTBD covenants that the ownership of the entire Equipment shall be deemed to have been transferred to the Institute. Further if in the event of the Equipment is transferred to the Institute at the end of 5 English Calendar years, then the Institute shall not terminate the MOU for minimum period of three (3) English calendar years from the end of the 5 calendar years on which date the Equipment may be transferred to the Institute and the Institute shall allow MTBD to continue the 'M - SHIKSHA' program.
- (P) The Institute shall hold MTBD and/or EXTRAMILE and/or any of its dealers harmless for any costs, damages, claims, expenses, actions, injury or death caused to and/or incurred by any of the staff of the Institute or instructor or student while undergoing the 'M - SHIKSHA' or while implementing the 'M - SHIKSHA' or while handling any of the Equipment's relating to 'M - SHIKSHA' or while traveling to or from the Institute to the dealership or any training center as the case may be in connection with any activity of 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (Q) The training to the Instructor may be provided at a nominal cost. The costs of the transportation of the instructor from the Institute to the venue of the training and back to the Institute and the costs of the boarding and/or lodging of the Instructor during the period of training shall be borne by the Institute.
- (R) MTBD shall wherever required provide the requisite safety gear to the Instructor during the training period and same shall be returned to MTBD by the Instructor after the training.

Further the Instructor shall follow all the safety norms and rules set out by MTBD from time to time which shall be the responsibility of the Instructor. Failure of the Instructor to adhere to the safety norms shall render the termination of the training of the instructor from the 'M - SHIKSHA' training.


- (S) The Institute shall not issue or provide or give any certificate or letter to any student with regard to having undergone the 'M - SHIKSHA' program. Only MTBD shall have the right to issue such certificate or letter. Any such issuance of certificate by the Institute shall be null and void and shall be deemed to be a violation of the MOU.

### 3. COVENANTS BY MTBD:-

- (A) MTBD agrees to give proper Equipment or aggregates to the Institute for the purpose of implementing the 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (B) MTBD agrees to give proper training to the Instructors and shall keep the Institute updated about the performance of the Instructor in the training and also the performance of the instructor in the implementation of the 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (C) MTBD shall try to resolve any problem the Institute may face with regard to the 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (D) MTBD shall keep the Institute updated about changes in the syllabus of 'M - SHIKSHA'.
- (E) MTBD agrees to implement the 'M - SHIKSHA' program without affecting the core curriculum and shall ensure that the 'M - SHIKSHA' shall in no way effect the regular calendar planned by the Institute to implement the core curriculum.

### 4. VALIDITY, TERMINATION, RESOLUTION OF DESPUTES AND GENERAL COVENANTS:-

- (A) The MOU shall come into effect from the date of execution and shall be valid for a period of 5 years and shall stand automatically terminated thereafter, unless the same has been renewed for such further period as may be mutually agreed between the Parties or unless terminated earlier by either Party by giving a sixty (60) calendar days written notice to the other Party without assigning any reason.
- (B) MTBD shall have the right to terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the Institute in the event, :-
- i) If the authorization given by MTBD to EXTRAMILE to implement the 'M - SHIKSHA' program is withdrawn;
  - ii) For any specific violation of any of the terms or clauses of the MOU by Institute;
  - iii) Order of any Court of Law or Appropriate Authorities prohibiting the programs like or similar to 'M - SHIKSHA';
  - iv) Any legislation passed by the State;
  - v) If any of the parties are declared a bankrupt or insolvent by the court of Law;
- (C) All disputes shall be tried to be resolved amicably by negotiations.

- (D) Only the courts in Mumbai city shall have jurisdiction over any dispute.
- (E) The MOU shall be deemed to have entered into at Mumbai both, MTBD and the Institute shall nominate one person respectively for coordinating the day-to-day activities of the 'M - SHIKSHA'. Where the coordinating persons fail to enter into any amicable settlement or fail to resolve the issue, then the problem shall be escalated to General Manager Customer Care of MTBD or the Principal or the Chairman or Director of the Institute. In the event the above persons fail to settle the disputes, they shall be finally settled by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by MTBD in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The award rendered by the arbitrator shall be a reasoned award and shall be final and binding upon both Parties. The proceedings shall be conducted and the award shall be rendered in English language. Mumbai shall be the seat of arbitration.

**5 WAIVER AND MODIFICATION**

No waiver of any breach of this MOU will constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach, and no waiver will be effective unless in writing and signed by the Party to be charged. This MOU may not be amended or modified except in writing signed by both Parties. The failure of either Party at any time to require performance by the other of any provisions of this MOU will in no way affect the full right of the Party to require the performance of any provisions at any later time.

**6 SEVERABILITY**

The invalidity or unenforceability of any term or any part of any term of, or any right arising pursuant to, this MOU, shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other terms or rights or the remainder of any such term or right which shall continue in full force and effect except for any such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof.

**7 COUNTERPARTS**


This MOU will be executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.

**8 RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES**

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to place the Parties in a relationship of joint ventures, partners, associates or principal and agent. Neither Party is granted the right to assume or create any obligation or responsibility for or on behalf of the other Party or otherwise bind the other Party other than as may be expressly authorized by the other Party in writing.

**9 SURVIVAL**

All obligations of the Parties which expressly or by their nature survive expiration or termination of this MOU shall continue in full force and effect subsequent to and notwithstanding such expiration and termination and until they are satisfied or by their nature expire.



NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE AS FOLLOWS:


1. This MOU is for collaboration between both parties, for mutual benefit, to enhance the quality of the educational experience of students of the Partner and for the specific purposes detailed in Annexure I of this MOU
2. Infosys shall be responsible for providing the requisite course material, publicity material such as handouts, information brochures and posters and conducting faculty enablement programmes as agreed between the parties.
3. The Partner shall be responsible for providing the requisite infrastructure, network and internet access and any other facility required for the education and training.
4. It is agreed that the terms and conditions of any agreed cooperative project (s) as outlined in Annexure 1 of this MOU shall be the subject matter of separate definitive agreements to be negotiated and agreed upon by the Parties and/or any third parties, wherever applicable, provided always the decision whether to initiate and/or implement any proposed cooperative projects shall be subject to the availability of funds and human resources on the part of each Party.
5. The parties, their representatives, and/or assignees, following the execution of this MOU, desire to maintain close contacts with each other to achieve the goals and objectives of, and to develop the ideas acknowledged in this MOU.
6. Both parties hereby agree to designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
7. Any expenses incurred by the parties for the purpose of this MOU shall be agreed upon and shall be borne as per the mutual agreement.
8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this MOU, neither party shall have any right to use any trademarks or trade name of the other party, nor to refer to this MOU or the obligations performed hereunder directly or indirectly, in connection with any product, promotion, or publication without the prior written approval of the other party
9. All information which has been disclosed to or obtained by either party at any time during the implementation of this MOU, is confidential information. For this purpose, the parties agree to sign the binding non-disclosure agreement in Annexure II.

10. The terms and conditions mentioned herein shall commence on the execution of this MOU and shall continue for a period of two (2) years from the date thereof or for such period as may be determined or extended by the parties from time to time by written notice, unless terminated by either party in accordance with this MOU. Either party may terminate this MOU at any time by providing three (3) months written notice to the other party.
11. Any notice required to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently served on the party if sent by hand or by registered post to the addresses of the party as stated in this MOU. Notices shall be deemed received: -
  - (i) If sent by registered mail, three (3) days after posting;
  - (ii) If by hand, on the day of delivery; and
  - (iii) If sent by telex or facsimile to the correct number or designated address within seventy-two (72) working hours.
12. Both parties agree to take all reasonable steps to ensure the successful completion of the collaboration, and co-operate with each other in duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.
13. The expiration and termination of this MOU will not affect the terms of those activities, which are in progress at the time of notification of expiry or termination of the MOU.
14. On the termination or expiry of this MOU or when requested by Infosys, the Partner undertakes to return all materials to Infosys without any delay.
15. Each party shall ensure that they do not actively solicit the faculty of the other party who is involved in the implementation of this MOU during the period of such faculty's involvement with the program and for six (6) months thereafter.
16. Both the parties agree that Infosys is not obliged on account of this MOU to recruit any fixed number of students from the Partner.
17. This MOU is an indication of good faith and intent on the part of both parties and does not create any legal obligations between them. In the event of any differences or disputes arising from the implementation of the provisions of this MOU, the parties shall as far as possible settle such differences or disputes in good faith by consultation or negotiation between the parties.
18. Save and except for Clause 6, Clause 7 and Clause 8, this MOU is not a legally binding contract and under no circumstances does this MOU subject either of the parties to liability for breach, whether material or minor, of contract or any other liability under international law or the laws of the country of the respective parties or any other applicable law.
